●Our [Community Guidelines](#) establishes a code of conduct for using TikTok.

- To go LIVE, you must be at least 18 years old, and your account must have a certain number of followers, which may vary by market. People must also be 18 or older to purchase coins and send gifts..

●We have Community Guidelines to create a welcoming, safe, and entertaining experience. The guidelines apply to everyone and everything on our platform. They include rules for what is allowed on TikTok, as well as standards for what is eligible for the For You feed (FYF).

TikTok's approach to content moderation

1. **Remove violative content** from the platform that breaks our rules
2. **Age-restrict mature content** so it is only viewed by adults (18 years and older)
3. **Maintain For You feed (FYF) eligibility standards** to help ensure any content that may be promoted by our recommendation system is appropriate for a broad audience
4. **Empower our community** with information, tools, and resources

Age Confirmation Process- Registration

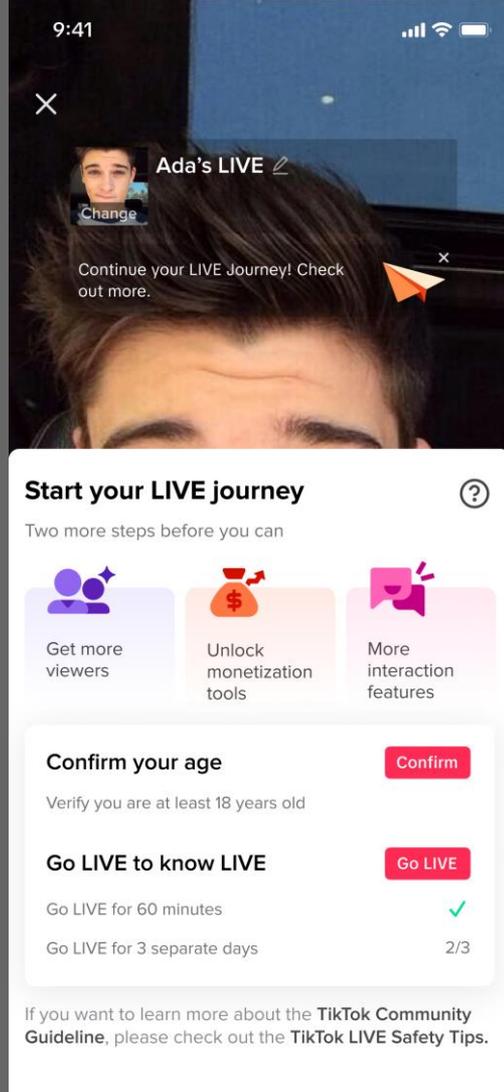
You must be 13 years and older to have an account.

Age Moderation-During LIVE

Even you have passed age verification, age moderation is still ongoing to avoid underage Live.

If an account holder believes they were incorrectly banned, they can [appeal](#) the decision.



Content Restricted for Young Audiences (18+)

Disordered Eating & Body image

Showing, describing, promoting, or offering or requesting coaching for: potentially harmful weight management behaviors, sharing before-and-after transformation, promoting body types as ideal or perfect, promoting cosmetic surgery that does not include risk warnings

Dangerous Activity & Challenges

Activity that is likely to be imitated that involves visible or imminent moderate physical harm, or promoting activity that is likely to lead to moderate physical harm

Gambling

Showing or glamorising gambling or gambling-like behaviour

Nudity & Body Exposure

Semi-nudity of adults, such as wearing only nipple covers or underwear that does not cover the majority of the buttocks

Sexually Suggestive Content

Adults engaging in intimate kissing, sexualised framing or behaviour, sex products

Alcohol, Tobacco & Drugs

Discussing drug or regulated substance use, showing excessive consumption of alcohol by adults, promoting of tobacco and alcohol

Shocking & Graphic Content

Human or animal blood, extreme physical fighting, graphic or distressing footage of events in public interest to view

Violent and Criminal Behavior

Violent and Criminal Behavior

We do not allow any violent threats, promotion of violence, incitement to violence, or promotion of criminal activities that may harm people, animals, or property.

NOT allowed

- Threatening or expressing a desire to cause physical injury to a person or a group
- Promoting or inciting violence, such as encouraging an attack or others to attack, praising a violent act, or recommending people bring weapons to a location to intimidate others
- Promoting theft, or the destruction of property or the natural environment
- Providing instructions on how to commit criminal activities that may harm people, animals, or property



Hate Speech & Hateful Behavior

Hate Speech & Hateful Behavior

We do not allow any hateful behavior, hate speech, or promotion of hateful ideologies. This includes explicit or implicit content that attacks a protected group, including:

- Caste
- Ethnicity
- National Origin
- Race
- Religion
- Tribe
- Immigration Status
- Gender
- Gender Identity
- Sex
- Sexual Orientation
- Disability
- Serious Disease

Hate Speech & Hateful Behavior

- **No promoting violence, segregation**, discrimination, and other harms on the basis of a protected attribute
- No promotion of hateful ideologies (e.g. racial supremacy, misogyny, anti-LGBTQ+)
- **No using hateful slurs** or dehumanizing people by saying or implying they are physically, mentally, or morally inferior, or calling them degrading terms, such as criminals, animals, and inanimate objects
- No denying or minimizing well-documented historical events that harmed protected groups, such as denying of the Holocaust or the genocide against the Tutsi in Rwanda

What's allowed? Educational and documentary content that raises awareness about the harm of hate speech, counterspeech, condemnation of, or satire about hateful ideologies, discussion of social issues that impact protected groups

NOT allowed

- Accounts operated by organizations or individuals that promote violence or hateful ideologies on or off-platform
- Providing material support to violent political organizations or promoting violence caused by them
- Promoting (including any praise, celebration, or sharing of manifestos) or providing material support to:
 - Hateful organizations
 - Individuals who cause serial or mass violence, or promote hateful ideologies
 - Violent criminal organizations
 - Violent extremists

Youth Sexual and Physical Abuse

Youth Sexual and Physical Abuse

TikTok is committed to providing a safe space for young people. **We do not allow showing, promoting or engaging in youth sexual or physical abuse or exploitation.**

- **No content** pertaining to child sexual abuse material, romantic relationships between an adult and young person (including paedophilia), grooming, sexual harassment is allowed on platform
- **No sexual solicitation**, including going off-platform or sharing sexually explicit images
- **No sharing (or threatening to share) details about, or shaming, a person's private sexual life**, including sexual history, names of previous sexual partners, and sexual orientation
- **No revictimizing young people** who have experienced abuse or exploitation, including through third party reshares



**Adult Sexual
and Physical Abuse**

Adult Sexual and Physical Abuse

TikTok embraces gender equity, supports healthy relationships, and respects intimate privacy. **We do not allow showing, promoting, or engaging in adult sexual or physical abuse or exploitation.**

- **Non-consensual sexual acts, image-based sexual abuse, sextortion, physical abuse, and sexual harassment are not allowed on platform**
- **No editing another person's content or image to sexualise them**, or to create the appearance of them engaging in sexual activity

What's allowed?

- Survivors of abuse or exploitation sharing their own experiences (as long as it does not show or graphically describe such content).
- Educational and documentary content that raises awareness about the harm of sexual exploitation and gender-based violence (as long as it does not show or graphically describe such content)

Human Trafficking and Smuggling

Human Trafficking and Smuggling

We do not allow human trafficking and smuggling.

- Human trafficking is **a form of modern slavery that can occur domestically or internationally** and involves the recruitment of victims, coordination of their transport, and their exploitation using force, fraud, coercion, or deception. It can include sex, labor, child, or organ trafficking, forced marriage, forced criminality (such as exploitative begging), domestic servitude, and child soldiers.
- Human smuggling involves **earning a profit by helping a person to illegally enter another country**. It can include providing transportation, consultation, identity, and travel document fraud.

NOT allowed

- Facilitating or promoting human smuggling acts and services
- Recruiting or coordinating human trafficking acts

Harassment and Bullying

Harassment & Bullying

Everyone should feel safe sharing their voice on TikTok without the fear of being degraded or bullied. We do not want trolls or toxic behavior on TikTok.

- No language or behavior that harasses, humiliates, threatens, or doxxes anyone e.g. “go and die”, “I wish you will get a disease”
- **No degrading someone or expressing disgust on the basis of their personal characteristics** or circumstances, e.g. physical appearance, intellect, personality traits, and hygiene
- **No retaliatory harassment** (but excludes non-harassing counter speech)
- We recognize that public figures are in a position of public attention and have ways to counter negative speech, so we do allow some negative or critical comments or images about public figures.

**Suicide
and Self-Harm**

Suicide and Self-Harm

We do not allow showing, promoting, or sharing plans for suicide or self-harm.

NOT allowed

- Showing, promoting, or providing instructions on suicide and self-harm, and related challenges, dares, games, and pacts, including naming or describing methods
- Showing or promoting suicide and self-harm hoaxes
- Sharing plans for suicide and self-harm

Disordered Eating and Body Image

Disordered Eating and Body Image

- **Disordered eating and dangerous weight loss behaviors** means extreme dieting or fasting, or misusing medication or engaging in exercise for weight loss that may create a significant and immediate health or well-being risk.
- **Potentially harmful weight management** means diets, medication, or exercise used for rapid or drastic weight loss or muscle gain that may create a long-term health or well-being risk.

NOT allowed

- Showing, describing, promoting, or offering or requesting coaching for disordered eating or dangerous weight loss behaviors, including:
 - Extreme low-calorie diets
 - Bingeing and intentional vomiting
 - Misusing medication or supplements for weight loss
 - Exercising through serious injuries or illness
- Showing or promoting unhealthy body measurement and "body checking" trends, such as comparing body part size to household objects
- **Facilitating** the trade or marketing of weight loss or muscle gain products



Dangerous Activity and Challenges

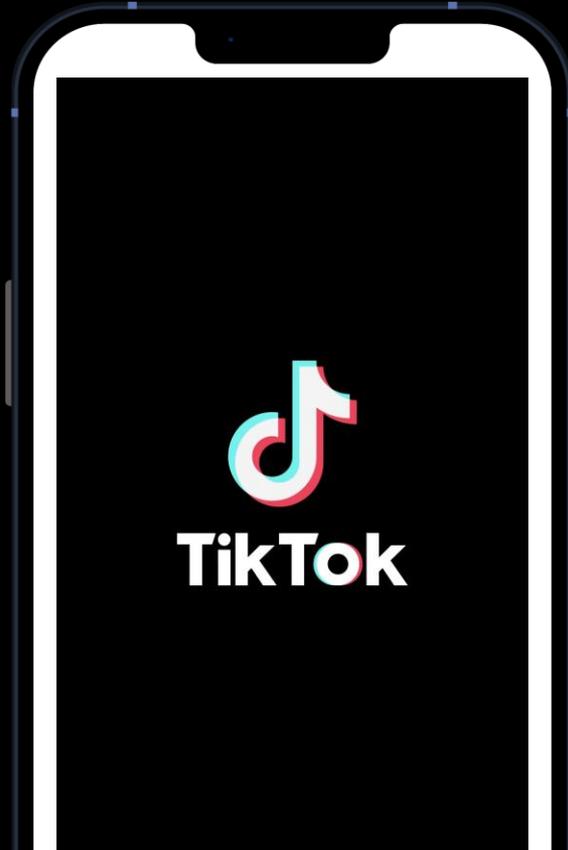
Dangerous Activity & Challenges

We love to see how creative our community gets, but sometimes, activities may carry a risk of significant injury. **We do not allow showing or promoting dangerous activity and challenges.**

- **Content is restricted (18+) if it shows activities likely to be imitated and lead to physical harm**
- No inappropriate use of dangerous tools (e.g. knives, chainsaws), eating substances dangerous for humans (e.g. detergent, rocks)
- No dangerous driving behavior (e.g. exceeding the speed limit, running a red light, posing for a picture or distracted driving including livestreaming while driving)

What's allowed? Using weapons, such as spears and shields, in ceremonial settings, religious festivals, and cultural practices

Sexual Activity and Services

Sexual Activity & Services

We want TikTok to be a welcoming place for conversations. This includes educational moments when people want to learn about sexuality, sex or reproductive health. Let's be mindful that certain content may not be appropriate for young people, may be offensive to some, or may create the potential for exploitation.

- **No sexual activity** (penetrative, non-penetrative sex, fetish) **or sexual services**
- No physical sexual arousal, including sexual stimulation and physical responses
- **No solicitation** of sexual services, sexual chats, imagery, pornography, member exclusive content (onlyfans)
- No streaming of adult content through a webcam, such as stripping, nude modeling, and masturbation (sexcamming)

What's allowed: reproductive health and sex education content, such as the use of birth control and abortion discussed in a medical or scientific context related to procedures, surgeries, or examinations

Nudity and Body Exposure

Nudity & Body Exposure

Different societies and cultures approach body exposure and clothing differently.

- **We do not allow nudity**, including bare genitals, buttocks, breasts of women and girls and sheer clothing.
- **We do not allow semi-nudity or significant body exposure of young people.** Content is ineligible for the FYF if it shows body exposure of a young person that may present a risk of uninvited sexualisation.
- No nude photography and digitally created images of adults and young people such as manga and anime
- **Content is restricted (18+)** if it shows semi-nudity of adults (nipple covers, underwear that doesn't cover majority of buttocks)

What's allowed? Regional exceptions include medical treatment, educational purposes, or as a part of culturally accepted practices, and contexts e.g. at the beach or at athletic events.

Sexually Suggestive Content

Sexually Suggestive Content

TikTok is a place where people can creatively express themselves, celebrate their culture, or seek to entertain. But certain behaviors may be offensive to some people, and may put young people at risk of exploitation.

- **No sexually suggestive content by young people:** no intimate kissing, sexualized framing or sexualised behaviour
- **Content is restricted (18+)** if it shows seductive performances or sexualized posing by adults, or allusions to sexual activity by adults
- **Content is FYF ineligible** if you show sex products or adults engaging in intimate behavior

What's allowed? Artistic content with sexual references (song lyrics), non-intimate greetings such as kissing someone on the cheeks

Shocking and Graphic Content

Shocking & Graphic Content

TikTok is not a place to intentionally shock, upset, or disgust others.

- **No gory, gruesome, disturbing, or extremely violent content**
- **Content is restricted (18+)** if it shows human or animal blood, extreme fighting or graphic footage of events
- Content is FYF ineligible if it shows fictional violence or potentially distressing or mildly graphic material

What's allowed? Professional fights, such as boxing or mixed martial arts, blood shown in an educational context (such as menstruation) and artistic settings (such as fine art), food-related blood products.

Animal Abuse

Animal Abuse

We do not allow animal abuse, cruelty, neglect, trade, or other forms of animal exploitation.

NOT allowed

- Slaughtering, mutilating, or abusing animals, including staged animal fighting
- Showing or promoting the mistreatment or neglect of animals, such as malnourishment
- Dismembered, mutilated, charred, burned, or severely injured animals
- Wildlife hunting without clear legal permission (poaching)
- Sexual activity between an animal and a human (bestiality)
- Facilitating the trade or marketing of all live animals, and any part of an endangered animal, such as products and medicine made from elephant ivory, tiger bones, rhinoceros horns, or sea turtle shells

Misinformation

Misinformation

In a global community, it is natural for people to have different opinions, but we seek to operate on a shared set of facts and reality.

- **No inaccurate, misleading, or false content** that may cause significant harm to individuals or society, regardless of intent
- General conspiracy theories or unverified information related to emergencies will be ineligible for the FYF
- Content that warrants fact-checking is also temporarily ineligible for the FYF while it is undergoing review



Civic and Election Integrity

Civic & Election Integrity

We want to enable informed exchange of civic ideas to foster productive dialogue.

- **No paid political promotion, political advertising**, or fundraising by politicians and political parties (for themselves or others)
- **No misinformation about civic and electoral processes**, regardless of intent
 - This includes misinformation about how to vote, registering to vote, eligibility requirements of candidates, the processes to count ballots and certify elections, and the final outcome of an election
- No unverified claims about the outcome of an election [*Ineligible for FYF*]



Edited Media and AI-Generated Content(AIGC)

Edited Media and AI-Generated Content (AIGC)

Artificial Intelligence (AI) and other digital technologies which can make it more difficult to distinguish between fact and fiction.

- **You are required to label AIGC or edited media** that shows realistic-appearing scenes or people. Visit the [Safety Centre](#) to learn more.
- We do not allow AI-generated content that shares or shows fake authoritative sources or crisis events, or falsely shows public figures in certain contexts.
- We are committed to protecting people's privacy. We do not allow content that contains the likeness of any real private figure that is not the creator, or depiction of children, without their permission.

Fake Engagement and Original Content

Fake Engagement and Original Content

TikTok is fun because of YOU and your authentic content.

- No trading of services to artificially increase engagement or deceive TikTok's recommendation system
- **No tricking or manipulating others to increase followers**, likes, or views e.g. “like-for-like” and false incentives
- **No providing instructions** on how to artificially increase engagement on TikTok

What is unoriginal or low quality content?

We consider content **not original** if it is imported or uploaded from TikTok, other platforms, or other sources including television, movies, or webcasts, and the user has not added new, creative edits.

- One indicator that the content is not original is a **visible watermark** or **superimposed logo**.

We do not allow content that violates someone else's intellectual property rights. If we become aware of content that is a violation, we will remove it. Learn more about our [intellectual property \(IP\) policies](#).

Low quality content includes extremely short clips, static images, and exclusively-GIF based videos.

Content that includes **QR codes** is usually ineligible for the FYF because it can lead users to harmful websites or apps.

Spam and Deceptive Behaviors

Spam & Deceptive Behaviors

We do not allow account behaviors that may spam or mislead our community.

- **Parody/fan-based accounts are allowed**, as long as they are disclosed in the account name (this is different than the @username)
- No covert influence operations, and operating spam or impersonation accounts
- **Do not set up multiple accounts** to intentionally bypass our rules or enforcement. If any of your accounts have been banned, or restricted from using a feature, you must not set up or use a different account to get around the ban or restriction.
 - You can set up multiple accounts on TikTok to create different channels for authentic creative expression, but not for deceptive purposes

Gambling, Alcohol, Tobacco and Drugs

Gambling, Alcohol, Tobacco & Drugs

People come to TikTok to discover fun ideas, creative communities and new products. But we do not want to promote vices on our platform, and we will moderate content that involves risky, addictive, dangerous and fraudulent behaviours.

- **No gambling on TikTok** (content will be restricted 18+ and FYF ineligible if such behavior is glamorized)
- **No showing young people possessing or using recreational drugs, or the trade of alcohol, tobacco products, and drugs**
 - No teaching how to make homemade spirits, drugs, or other regulated substances
- **Content is restricted (18+)** and ineligible for FYF if it shows adults consuming tobacco products or excessive amounts of alcohol



**Firearms and
Dangerous Weapons**

Firearms and Dangerous Weapons

We do not allow the trade of firearms or explosive weapons, or content showing or promoting them if they are not used in a safe or appropriate setting.

- **Firearms** includes professionally manufactured firearms, improvised firearms (such as ghost guns and 3D printed guns), firearm accessories, and ammunition.
- **Safe or appropriate settings** include professional contexts (such as military and police), recreational environments (such as shooting ranges and hunting), educational forums, and fictional settings.

NOT allowed

- Facilitating the trade of, or offering instructions on how to make, firearms or explosive weapons
- Marketing of firearms or explosive weapons
- Showing or promoting firearms or explosive weapons that are not used in a safe or appropriate setting

Trade of Regulated Goods and Services

Trade of Regulated Goods and Services

NOT allowed

Facilitating the trade of regulated, prohibited, or high-risk goods and services, including the following:

- Gambling or gambling-like activities
- Alcohol and tobacco products
- Illegal drugs, prescription and over-the-counter drugs, weight loss or muscle gain products, and other regulated substances
- Firearms and explosive weapons
- Counterfeit products, such as luxury goods
- Fake currency, documents, and stolen information
- Services that artificially increase engagement
- Sexual services, including offering or asking for sexual acts (solicitation), sexual chats, imagery, pornography, member exclusive content, and streaming of adult content through a webcam, such as stripping, nude modeling, or masturbation (sexcamming)
- Live animals, and any part of an endangered animal, such as products and medicine made from elephant ivory, tiger bones, rhinoceros horns, or sea turtle shells
- Any items that promote hate speech, hateful ideologies, or hateful organizations, such as books or clothing with hateful logos

Commercial Disclosures and Paid Marketing

Commercial Disclosures and Paid Marketing

If you market a business, product, or service you must disclose it using the content disclosure setting. This includes marketing for yourself, or a third party brand, product, or service in exchange for payment or other incentive. Marketing content is ineligible for the FYF if it is not disclosed using the content disclosure setting. For other types of material relationships, you must make a clear disclosure about such connections.

REQUIRED Disclosure

- Content marketing your business, product, or service
- Content marketing a third party brand or its business, product, or service in exchange for payment or any other incentive
- Other material relationships, such as research about a product, service, or industry when you have a relationship or connection with a company or industry involved in the manufacture or sale of that product or service, by making a clear disclosure in a caption, watermark, or sticker

Frauds and Scams

Frauds & Scams

TikTok can be a place to learn about ways to be financially responsible and consider economic transactions or investment opportunities. **We do not allow creators to defraud or scam members of our global community.**

We do not permit content that

- Facilitates financial and individual-targeted scams, identity theft or phishing scams, and scams related to investments, financial transactions, or jobs
- Coordinating, facilitating, or instructing on how to carry out scams
- Facilitating organizational fraud, such as money laundering or moving illegally acquired money for someone else
- Recruiting for multi-level marketing companies
- Facilitating the trade of fake currency, documents, and stolen information

Privacy and Security

Personal Information

Personal Information

We do not allow content that includes personal information that may pose a risk of stalking, violence, phishing, fraud, identity theft, or financial exploitation.

NOT allowed

- Personal non-public phone numbers and home addresses
- Financial and payment information, such as bank account or credit card numbers
- Login information, such as usernames or passwords
- Identity documentation, cards, or numbers, such as passports, government-issued identifications, or social security numbers
- Threats or encouragement to share personal information or to hack an account

Platform Security

Platform Security

We do not allow: **(1) access to any part of TikTok through unauthorized methods;** **(2) attempts to obtain sensitive, confidential, commercial, or personal information;** or **(3) any abuse of the security, integrity, or reliability of our platform.**

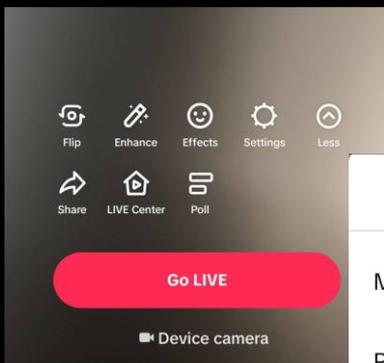
NOT allowed

- Providing other people with access to your account credentials or enabling other people to conduct activities that violate our rules
- Accessing our platform in an unauthorized way, or creating fake versions of our platform
- Sharing malicious files, content, and messages that contain viruses, Trojan horses, worms, logic bombs, or other harmful materials endangering cyber security
- Attempting to obtain personal information (such as login credentials) or access content, accounts, systems, or data through the use of any deceptive technique (such as phishing, smishing, automated scripts, or web crawling)
- Modifying, adapting, translating, reverse engineering, disassembling, decompiling, or creating any derivative products based on TikTok, including any files, tables or documentation, and attempting to regenerate any source code, algorithms, methods, or techniques embodied in TikTok

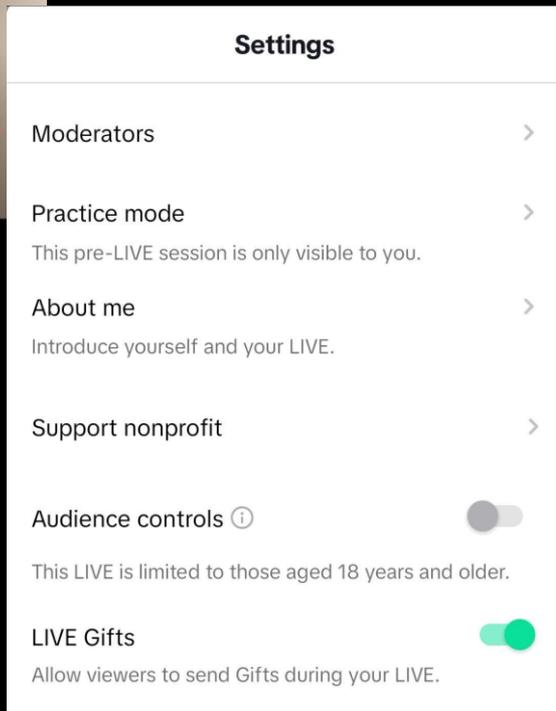

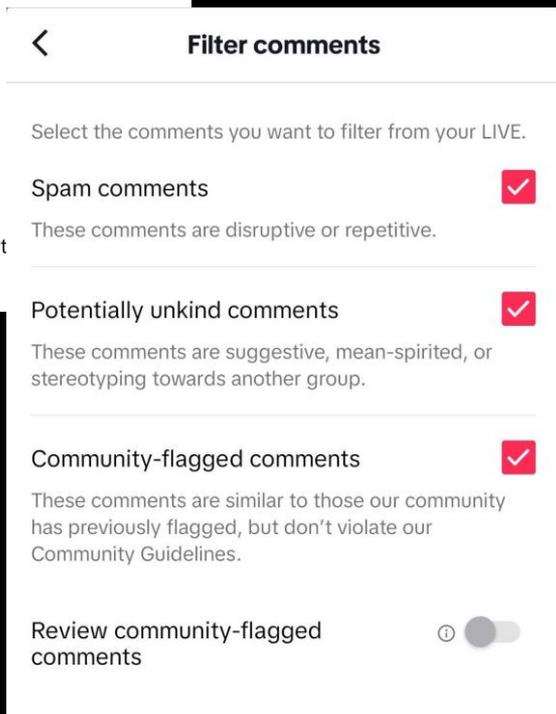
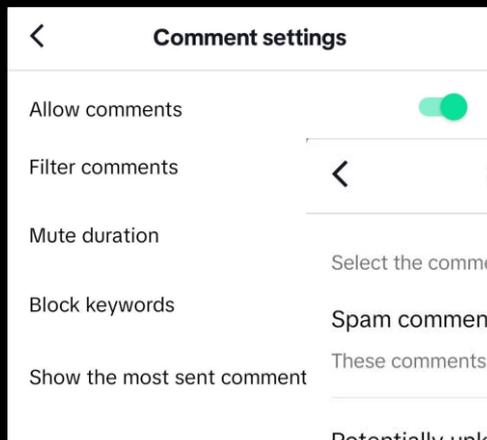

Setting up the session

We encourage hosts to key in as much information as possible:

- Audience controls (for content suitability)
- To add moderators during LIVE



Filtering comments

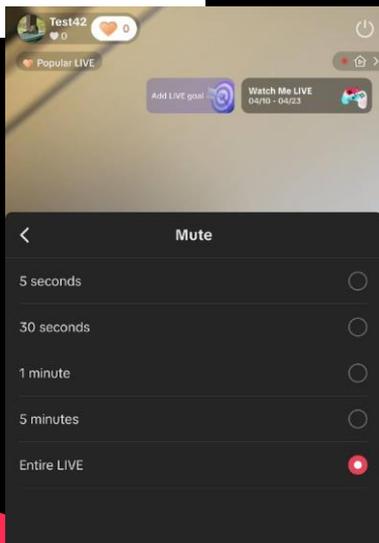
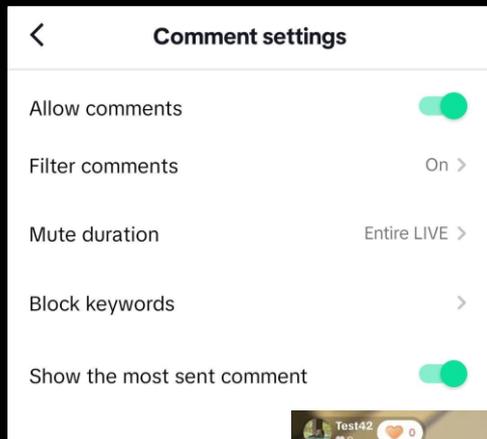
Turn this on to filter potentially unkind or community-flagged comments. This setting is only available to creators.

We encourage hosts to set up some filters on to help focus on the topics that are being discussed in their LIVE without interruption or distraction.

Creators and their moderators can also review what is flagged by our model, within the comment stream in real-time, and give direct feedback (agree/disagree).

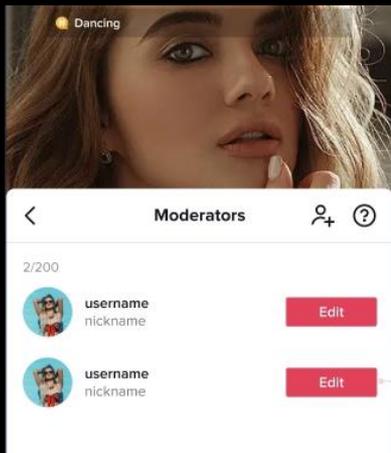
Mute duration of comments

Hosts can customise the duration of your choice in LIVE Settings: select Mute and then select the duration.

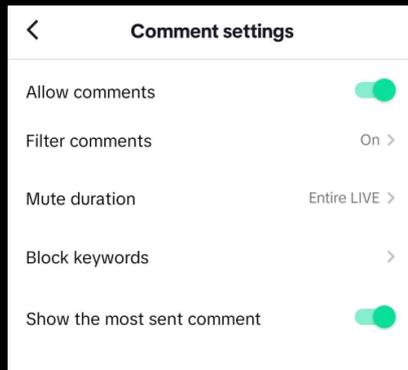
Select how long you'd like to mute comments for during your LIVE. You can choose to mute comments for the entire time you're LIVE or for a select amount of time.

For host safety, to prevent someone from engaging with their LIVE permanently, hosts may use our LIVE blocking feature.

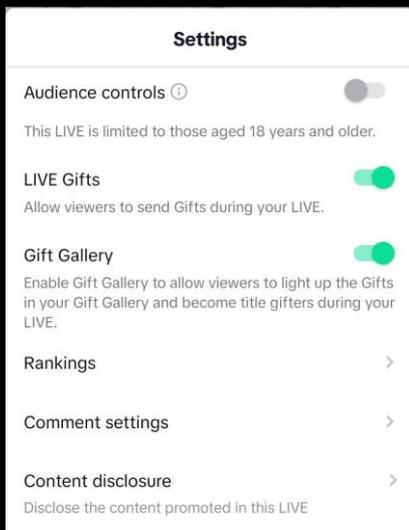

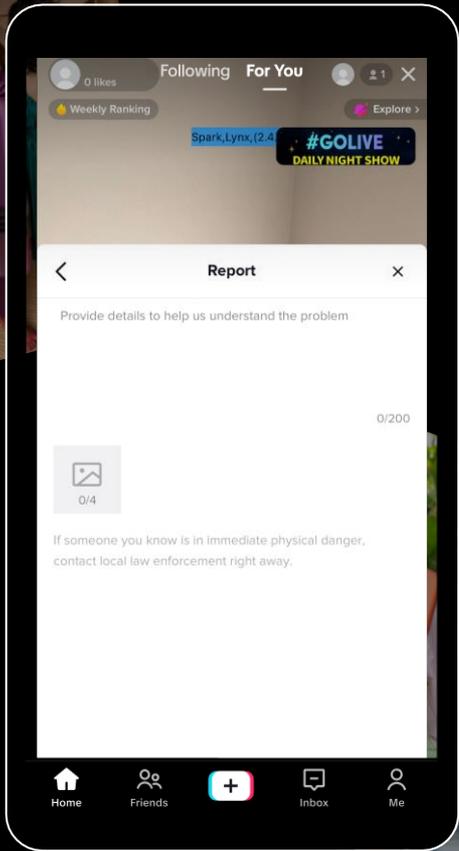
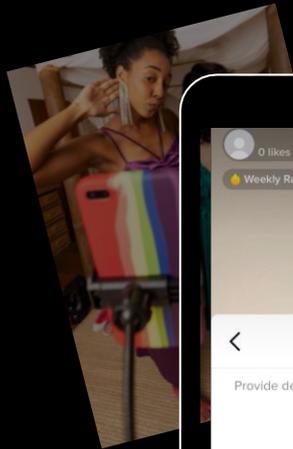


Keeping safe with community moderators

As a creator or moderator on TikTok LIVE, you can report, mute, limit, or block viewers who violate our [Community Guidelines](#) or send unwanted messages in the LIVE chat. Creators can also add people as moderators to assist with managing viewers during the LIVE.

- Choose your preference for the following settings
 - Audience control to limit to only adult viewers
 - Mute, block other users within a LIVE room
 - Different level of filtering comments, and even review what is filtered

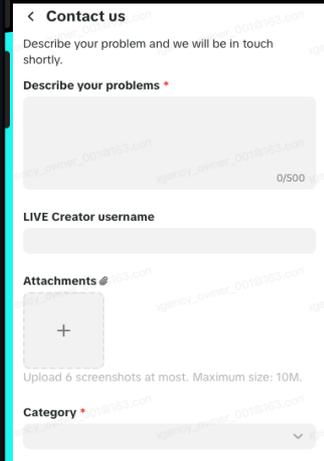
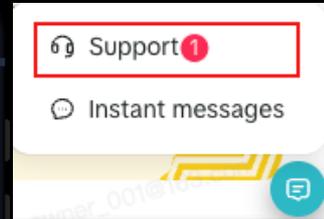
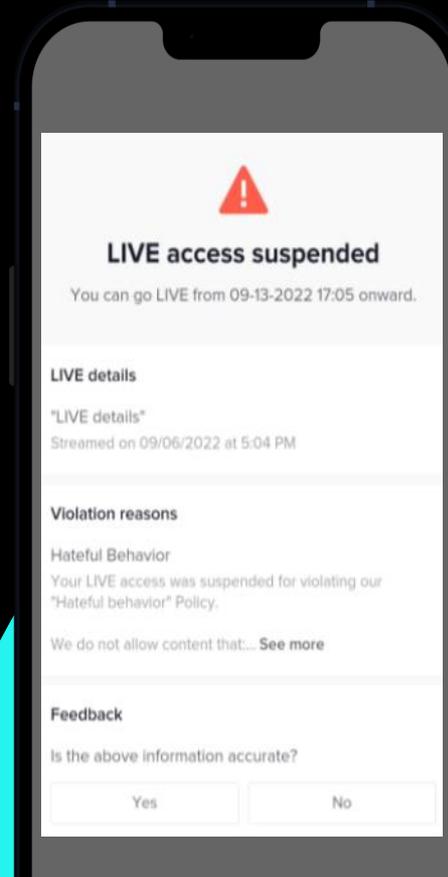
